GOATY HILL PINOT NOIR 2009

As the vineyard has now reached its full potential, partners in Goaty Hill Wines decided to launch a wine label that encapsulated their passion for quality and enjoyment of fine Tasmanian wine. In considering a name for their label, partners turned to their vineyard for inspiration. A notable landmark on the property includes a steep and rocky hill that offers panoramic views of the region; a journey to the top is well worth the effort. This hill is locally known as Goaty Hill.

This thought provoking wine has been crafted from an ultra low yielding single block estate grown Pinot Noir. Included in the process is only the finest French oak and 20% whole bunch ferments. This exciting wine has great lift and freshness to both the aroma and flavour. The

Vintage Condition

It was a wet start to the season, which continued through until flowering. Low crops ensued. The vintage made for very upfront fruit flavours complimented with long acid finishes.

Appearance

Stunning Deep red with plumish hues.

Bouquet

Dark plum with oaky spice and roasted beetroot. Toasty and savoury.

Palate

Opulently luscious and rich. You will enjoy dark red fruit flavors with full but soft tannins. Exciting flavours include cinnamon bark, dry coriander seed and char dried toast complimented with a savoury long finish.
